S.T.A.R. PROGRAM (SCHOLARSHIP, TALENT, ACHIEVEMENT, RECOGNITION)

- **General Eligibility:** The NCU STAR Scholars Program is available to both U.S.-based and international students who are applying for admission into any of NCU's undergraduate programs.
- **Award:** The NCU STAR Scholarship recipients will receive a scholarship covering half of the tuition fees for their first trimester of study.
- **Number of Awards:** Annually, 50 scholarships are available for students entering the fall trimester.
- **General Requirements:** Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
